SPOTTED LANTERNFLY PERMIT NEEDED IN PA!

As of May 1, some businesses that operate in one of the fourteen Pennsylvania counties that are considered to be **Spotted Lanternfly** quarantine zones must obtain and carry a permit showing that the company is in compliance with insect inspection and control training. Companies that are based in the quarantine zone, load in the quarantine zone, or that make stops in the quarantine zone all must obtain the permit.

The 'hard enforcement' will include **random roadside stops** conducted by state police and the Department of Agriculture to ensure that drivers are carrying the proper permit and drivers may be asked a question or two related to training.

The Spotted Lanternfly is an invasive species native to Asia that poses a major threat to crops like grapes and hops.
